Position Title: Service Clinical Director – Reablement Services

Brief Description: We are looking for a senior clinical leader to support the development of quality adult rehabilitation services across ADHB. This is an exciting opportunity for a clinician with leadership skills and experience to support our ward based staff in transformation and delivery of quality patient care within the Community and Long Term Conditions Directorate. Reablement Services consists of a large multi-disciplinary team of clinicians who are responsible for delivering health care services across our five wards. The focus is on the delivery of goal centred, holistic care to reduce the impact of frailty, disability and impairment and on supporting independence. The team comprises of geriatricians, rehabilitation physicians, allied health and nursing staff and are supported by a comprehensive administration team. As the Service Clinical Director you will manage the service's clinical workforce of 200 FTE and have four direct reports (an operations manager, nurse manager, lead clinician and allied health team leader). This permanent position is negotiable up to 1 FTE with a 40/60 leadership/clinical component split. For suitably-qualified clinicians there will be the potential for an appropriate University appointment and the opportunity to grow the research portfolio within the Directorate.
